Organised by our Education Officer and chaired by the Director of Pre-vocational Education and Training (DPET), the JMO M&M (Morbidity and Mortality) meeting is run towards the end of each term. JMOs have the opportunity to reflect on clinical scenarios where patients have had near miss or adverse outcomes due to a clinical error, and analyse how this came to be and how this could be prevented in future. The meetings are strictly confidential, and provide a means for self-improvement and debriefing about difficult scenarios. Acknowledgement in social media will occur during the lead up to and at the start of the event, as part of our promotional campaign. Note: lunch must be individually packaged (e.g. bowls of food) or a server wearing gloves and using tongs must provide food onto plates, as per our hospital's COVID-19 policy.

New in 2023, St George Hospital RMOA are building a portfolio of exclusive Membership Deals for our members. Partnering with us is a fantastic means to build a relationship and brand loyalty with junior medical officers (JMOs) early in their career, before they begin taking their teams out for a meal as a senior registrar or consultant, or providing junior doctors with recommendations on whether to get the best equipment and cool down and debrief.
